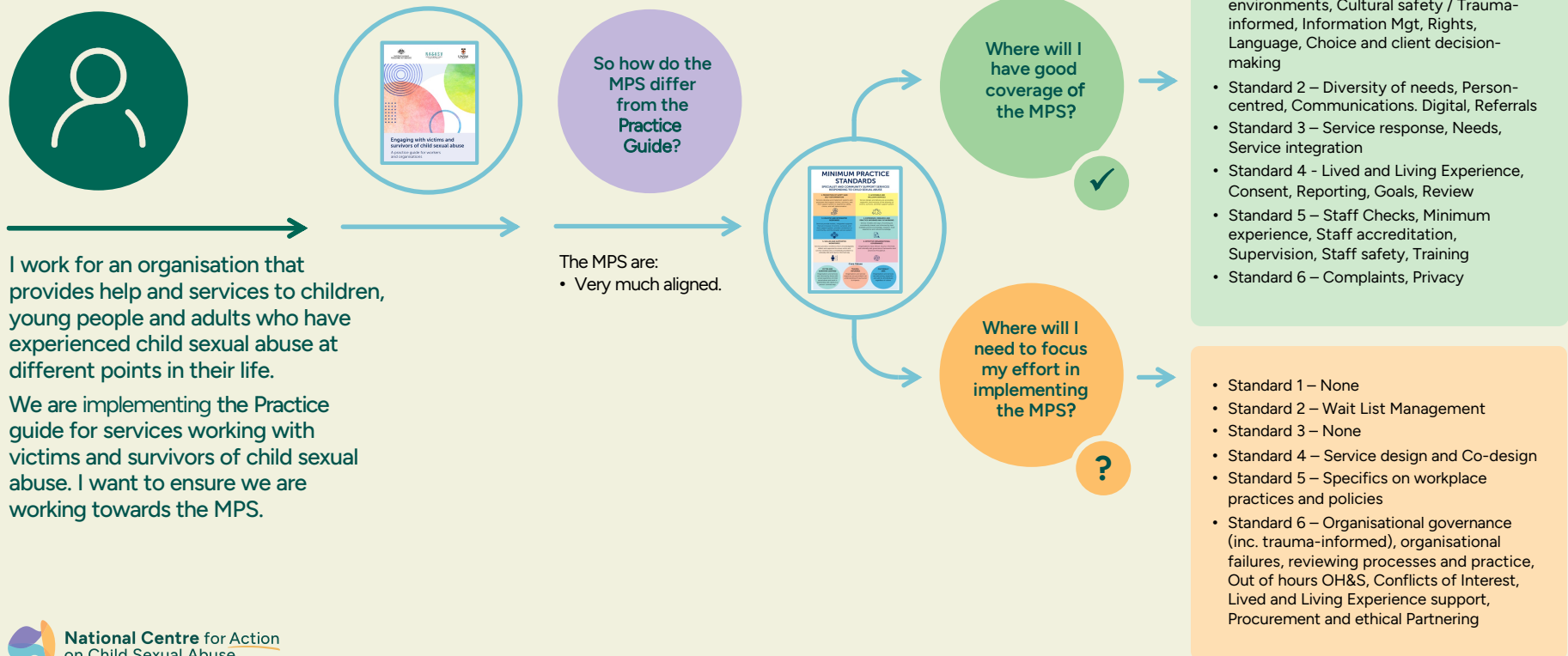


## Supporting the implementation of the Minimum Practice Standards for Specialist and Community Support Services Responding to Child Sexual Abuse (MPS)

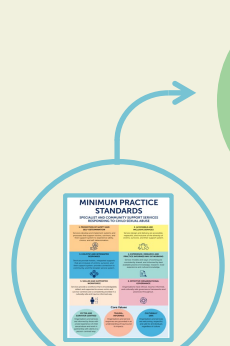
For organisations who have already implemented the *Engaging with victims and survivors of child sexual abuse: A practice guide for workers and organisations* (Practice Guide)
